

# FICHMAN FURNITURE AND RADIATOR COVERS

## Radiator Cover Assembly Instructions – Easy Assembly in About 5 Minutes

**CAUTION:** EDGES OF RADIATOR SCREENS ON THE REVERSE OF THE FRONT AND SIDES MAY HAVE SHARP EDGES. TO AVOID CUTS TO YOUR SKIN, DO NOT TOUCH THEM AND USE CARE WHEN HANDLING THESE PARTS.

**CAUTION:** TALL AND NARROW RADIATORS ARE MUCH LIKE PIECES OF FURNITURE AND CAN TIP OVER. DO NOT SIT OR STAND ON THE RADIATOR COVERS, DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN OR PETS TO CLIMB THEM. IF THIS IS A POTENTIAL RISK IN YOUR HOME, TAKE CARE TO TEACH CHILDREN OF THIS DANGER, AND SECURE THE RADIATOR COVER TO YOUR WALL OR FLOOR. IF YOU ARE UNSURE HOW TO DO THIS, SEEK THE HELP OF A LOCAL QUALIFIED CONTRACTOR.

**RECOMMENDED:** WE RECOMMEND INSPECTING THE RADIATOR COVER EVERY TIME IT IS MOVED AND AT LEAST ONCE YEARLY TO ENSURE THAT IT HAS REMAINED SECURELY ASSEMBLED AND NO JOINTS HAVE COME LOOSE.

### Step 1

Assemble the left and right covers according to our standard assembly instructions. The left cover will not have a right panel and the right cover will not have a left panel.

### Step 2

Aside from the radiator cover parts detailed in our standard assembly instructions, you will find another bag of hardware that contains several Flip Bolts. The quantity will vary depending on the size of your radiator cover.

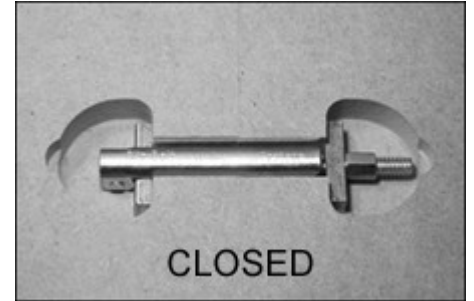
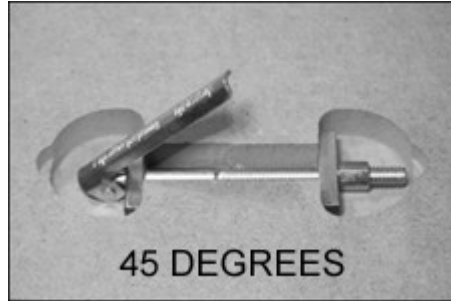
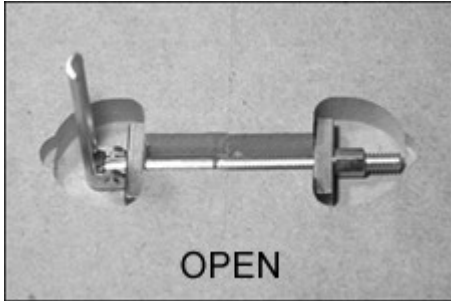


### Step 3

On your blanket, place the assembled covers next to each other but upside down on their tops. Align the mushroom shaped holes in the top panels and drop a flip bolt into each pair of holes.

#### Step 4

With the lever in the upright (OPEN) position, hand tighten the nut until it feels tight. If you press the lever down to approximately 45 degrees and feel that it is giving some resistance, back the lever off, align the surfaces of the panels for flushness with your other hand and then tighten (CLOSE) the lever all the way. If it did not give resistance, tighten the nut some more and try again. Do so until it is fully tightened. It should be reasonably difficult to undo the lever once it is locked down. Repeat this step for the other flip bolts in the top and then the front panel.



#### Step 5

Slide the cover over your radiator and secure it to the wall! Long covers need the added security of this step to be safe and prevent possibility of collapse. Be sure to inspect the assembly of your radiator cover on a regular basis and after every time it is moved. Verify that all of the assembly hardware is tight to ensure it is a solid structure.
